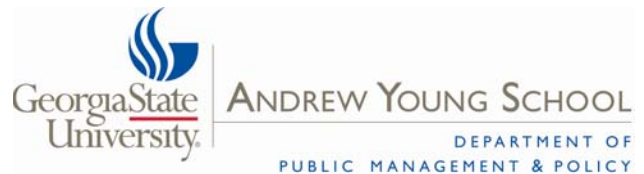


# Master of Public Policy (Nonprofit Policy Concentration)
