

The Dan E. Sweat Dissertation Fellowship

The Dan E. Sweat Dissertation Fellowship Program invites applications from doctoral students who are writing dissertations. The Fellowship is sponsored by the Dan E. Sweat Distinguished Scholar Chair in Educational and Community Policy.

The Dissertation Fellowship in the amount of \$5,000 is designed to support completion of dissertation research. The dissertation must address an urban, community or education issue and have some policy relevance. The dissertation could be based in any discipline, including but not limited to: anthropology, economics, education, geography, history, political science, psychology, or sociology.

Applicants must be a Georgia State University doctoral student and have passed their proposal defense prior to the application deadline. Applicants can be from any department.

The application deadline is November 30, 2009.

To apply, submit 4 copies of the following:

- A completed application form is attached (a copy of the form can also be found at <http://aysps.gsu.edu/frc/files/fellowship.pdf>);
- A summary of your dissertation (maximum of 1500 words; approximately 5 pages doubled spaced);
- Curriculum vitae (not to exceed four pages).

A letter of support from your dissertation advisor is also required. This letter must be sent directly by your advisor to the address below.

Fellowship awardees are expected to acknowledge the fellowship award in the dissertation and any publications that result from the dissertation research.
