ROY W. BAHL JR., DEAN OF THE SCHOOL OF POLICY STUDIES AND PROFESSOR OF ECONOMICS AND PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION, JOINED GEORGIA STATE UNIVERSITY IN 1988. AN EXPERT IN PUBLIC FINANCE, HE HAS SERVED AS A DIRECTOR OF THE SOUTHERN GROWTH POLICIES BOARD SINCE 1995. BAHL PREVIOUSLY DIRECTED THE METROPOLITAN STUDIES PROGRAM AND WAS MAXWELL PROFESSOR OF POLITICAL ECONOMY AT SYRACUSE UNIVERSITY IN NEW YORK. HE ALSO HAS HELD POSITIONS AT WEST VIRGINIA UNIVERSITY AND THE INTERNATIONAL MONETARY FUND.

BAHL, 60, HAS CONSULTED WIDELY WITH PUBLIC AND PRIVATE AGENCIES ON ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AS WELL AS STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT FINANCE ISSUES. HE WAS STAFF DIRECTOR FOR BOTH THE GEORGIA AND OHIO TAX REFORM COMMISSIONS AND HAS WRITTEN NUMEROUS BOOKS AND SCHOLARLY PAPERS ON URBAN/REGIONAL ECONOMICS, PUBLIC FINANCE AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT. BAHL HAS SERVED ON THE EDITORIAL BOARDS OF THE *National Tax Journal*, *American Review of Public Administration*, *The Journal of Public Budgeting and Finance*, AND *Growth and Change*, AMONG OTHERS. HIS MOST RECENT SCHOLARLY BOOK, *Fiscal Reform in China*, WAS PUBLISHED THIS YEAR BY THE UNIVERSITY OF MICHIGAN PRESS.

BAHL IS PRINCIPAL ECONOMIC ADVISER FOR IBM'S WORLDWIDE TAX GROUP AND SERVES AS LEAD CONSULTANT ON INTERGOVERNMENTAL FISCAL RELATIONS FOR THE WORLD BANK'S URBAN AND REGIONAL DEPARTMENT. HE HAS ADVISED GOVERNMENTS IN CHINA AND RUSSIA, AS WELL AS DEVELOPING COUNTRIES IN THE FAR EAST, LATIN AMERICA, THE CARIBBEAN

AND AFRICA, ON FISCAL MATTERS. BAHL ALSO HAS LED MAJOR TAX REFORM PROJECTS FOR RUSSIA, JAMAICA AND GUATEMALA.

A NATIVE OF MIAMI, BAHL RECEIVED HIS BACHELOR'S DEGREE FROM GREENVILLE COLLEGE IN ILLINOIS IN 1961, AND HIS MASTER'S AND DOCTORAL DEGREES FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF KENTUCKY IN 1963 AND 1965, RESPECTIVELY.
