<sup>1</sup>SW 8300- Leadership and Management is a required course for the Fall semester; however, the course is offered online in the Summer semester as well. If there are spaces available in SW 8300, you have the option to take it during the Summer semester and take the social work elective in the Fall. Please note that this “required” **social work** elective is in addition to the elective you still need to take in the Fall.

\*The program of study includes two (2) elective courses in addition to the SW elective taken during the Summer Semester. One of these two (2) electives must be a social work elective and the other may be a social work or non-social work elective. If you choose to add a certificate program to your MSW degree, you may use the two (2) elective slots to fulfill certificate requirements. School of Social Work must be notified if pursuing a certificate program, so the social work elective requirement can be modified in your official record.
