

Application instructions for the Joint Doctoral Program in Public Policy with Georgia State University's [Andrew Young School of Policy Studies](#) and Georgia Institute of Technology's [School of Public Policy](#).

The application process for the joint program requires applicants to submit applications and supporting documents to both institutions. The non-refundable application fee covers the submission to both institutions (do not submit two application fees!).

Follow these steps to apply:

1. **Submit [Georgia Tech application](#):**
 - Program is listed as "**Public Policy (Joint program with Georgia State University)**"
2. **Submit Non-Refundable Application Fee through the Georgia Tech Online Application:**
 - \$95 for U.S. applicants
 - \$105 for international applicants
3. **Submit [Georgia State University application](#):**
 - Program is listed as "**Public Policy - Joint Program; Doctor of Philosophy.**"
 - **Note:** Only submit your application; do not pay the application fee. Applications that have been submitted and paid are not eligible for a refund.
4. **Submit the [GSU Joint Ph.D. Application Fee Waiver Request Form](#):**
 - Complete this [online form](#) to process your application fee waiver for the Georgia State University application.
5. **Submit Required Application Materials to Both Institutions:**
